Dear Customers, Business Partners,

Due to the **comprehensive renovation works** announced by the German infrastructure manager (DB InfraGO AG) on the **Hamburg-Berlin railway corridor**, scheduled from **August 1, 2025, to April 30, 2026**, all PCC Intermodal services affected by this closure will be rerouted via Magdeburg and Hannover.

The change of current rail routing caused by necessary detour of the closed rail infrastructure will result in longer distances, slightly extended transit times, and **significantly increased operational costs**, including access charges, traction costs, train path planning and technical support.

In light of these additional burdens and to maintain the highest quality of service, **PCC Intermodal S.A.** will introduce a temporary **infrastructure surcharge of €18/TEU**, effective from **August 1, 2025**.

This surcharge will apply to all transports affected by the rerouting through Germany, i.e. PCC Intermodal's service **to and from Hamburg** and will remain in effect until regular operations on the Hamburg-Berlin route are restored.
